For the past 24 years, **René Stettler** has been organizing the Swiss Biennial on Science, Technics and Aesthetics since its inception in Lucerne in 1994. This time, he has invited leading researchers from neuroscience and cognitive science, philosophy of mind, Buddhism, cosmology, physics, and artificial intelligence as well as from research fields concerned with the effects of consciousness-expanding substances from the USA, Brazil, Chile, UK, Italy, the Netherlands, and Switzerland.

An interdisciplinary platform, the 12th Biennial will ask questions such as: **Can human consciousness be explained? How does it work? Why is it so puzzling? Is there a scientific explanation for its emergence? What is primary: the brain or the mind?** The panel discussion will be conducted by the well-known American radio moderator **Steve Paulson**, Executive Producer of *To the Best of Our Knowledge* at Wisconsin Public Radio.
